OFFICE ORDER

Consequent upon the decision taken by the Government vide OM No.Z.28015/119/2012-H dated 17-12-2012 (Copy enclosed), the Patient Care Allowance will be doubled from the existing i.e. Rs.1380/- from Rs.690/- w.e.f. 01-09-2008 to existing eligible Group C &D (Non-Ministerial) employees. The amount of PCA would be automatically raised by 25% every time the Dearness Allowance on the revised pay structure goes up by 50%. This is subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- (i) PCA may be admissible in case the individual proceeds on leave/training for less than one calendar month.
- (ii) PCA may not be admissible in case the individual proceeds on leave/training for more than one calendar month.
- (iii) PCA should not be admissible in case of unauthorized leave.

All the eligible Group C &D (Non-Ministerial) employees are also entitled for arrears of PCA.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Doubling of existing rate of Payment of Hospital Patient Care Allowances/Patient Care Allowances to eligible Group 'C' & 'D' (Non-Ministerial) employees working in Hospitals, Dispensaries and Organizations w.e.f. 1.09.2008.

The undersigned is directed to convey the approval of the Union Cabinet for doubling the existing rate of payment of HPCA/PCA to all eligible Group 'C' & 'D' employees working in Hospitals, Dispensaries and Organizations in the Central Government from the period w.e.f. 01.09.2008. The amount of HPCA/PCA would be automatically raised by 25% every time the Dearness Allowance on the revised pay structure goes up by 50%. This is subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- (i) HPCA/PCA may be admissible in case the individual proceeds on leave/training for less than one calendar month.
- (ii) HPCA/PCA may not be admissible in case the individual proceeds on leave/training for more than one calendar month.
- (iii) HPCA/PCA should not be admissible in case of unauthorized leave.

This issues with the approval of Department of Personnel & Training vide their No.21012/01/2010-Estt.(AL) dated 18th October, 2012 and U.O. of even number dated December, 2012.
