Responsibilities

1. To under take vector surveillance and timely analyze/interpret the data for effective implementation of integrated vector management strategies..
2. To study the susceptibility status of the vector in different areas.
3. To undertake a short-term result oriented studies in areas of double resistance or where mosquitoes are refractory to adulticides for taking up anti-larva measures in a selective way.
4. To monitor and evaluate the source reduction activities and community mobilization.
5. To impart training for spray operations for different insecticides in coordination with the state health authorities while taking a policy decision for spray.
6. To undertake evaluation after usual rounds of spray.
7. To carry out entomological assessment to know the impact of programme interventions and prediction of epidemic/outbreak of vector borne disease.
8. To carry out biological testing (bio-assay) of insecticides.
9. To undertake research on entomological techniques and procedures for adoption under the programme.
10. To study the drug sensitivity status of *P.falciparum* in different areas and mapping of drug resistant areas to change the drug regimen.
11. Any other assignment given by superior.

Qualification and Experiences

Essential:-

- 1) Master 's degree in Zoology with Entomology of a recognised University or equivalent.
- 2) Seven years experience in teaching and/ or research and/or control in the field of medical Entomology or Malariology or Filariology.

Desirable:

- 1) Doctorate in Entomology.
- 2) Training in advanced Medical Entomology/ Malariology or Filariology.)

Nature of appointment

The appointment of the Consultant will be on contract basis initially for a period of one year (subject to satisfactory performance) and extendable further on basis of performance.

Reporting

The overall In-charge of Consultants would be the Sr. Regional Director NVBDCP.

Age

Should not be above 50 years and ready to travel extensively.

Remuneration

The will be 50,000/- per month with a provision of 10 % annual increment subject to satisfactory performance as per assessment by the reviewing officer.

Other Entitlements
